Co-ops exist to serve their communities instead of shareholders. We distribute and sell energy at cost and invest any excess revenue back into the electric system.

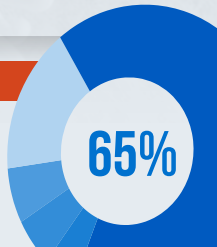


COMMITTED TO COMMUNITY

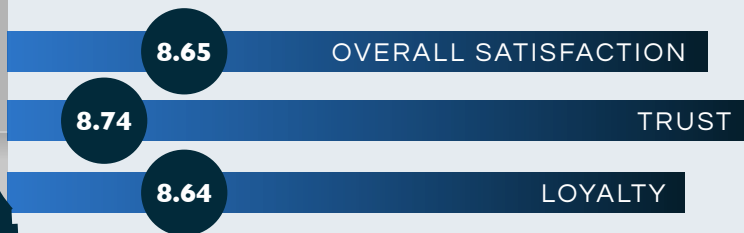
Keeping the lights on. Recruiting new industry. Educating the leaders of tomorrow. Electric co-ops take seriously our responsibility to improve lives in our communities.

65 percent of co-op members believe their cooperative does a better job of improving the community than other service providers, including telephone (5%), cable (6%) and satellite (6%) companies.

When asked to rate their local electric cooperative on a 10 point scale, our members gave us high marks for satisfaction, trust and loyalty.

YOUTH

Tennessee's electric co-ops have sent more than 6,000 young Tennesseans to Washington, D.C., as a part of our annual Youth Tour program. We are committed to educating and preparing tomorrow's leaders.

RELIABILITY

Keeping the lights on is a fundamental part of what we do, and we are very good at it. Tennessee co-ops kept the lights on 99.96 percent of the time, despite ice storms, tornados and other extreme weather events.

COMMUNITY

The Co-op Connections Card program has saved Tennesseans more than \$1.5 million on prescription drugs. The card also provides savings on dental, vision and other services.

DEVELOPMENT

Tennessee electric cooperatives secure more than \$4 million in economic development loans in 2013. We fund regional industrial development, bringing jobs and investment to our communities.
